Directions:

From I-35 use exit 72 to Pauls Valley. Take hwy. 19 to Ada, 32 miles. On west side of Ada, take the Seminole/McAlester exit 1 mile then the McAlester/ Ada exit. From I-40 take Seminole exit hwy. 99 south to the McAlester/Ada. Exit. Agri-plex is on the left at the first stoplight.

ENTRY FEES:

- Open, Youth and Amateur per class.....\$25.00
- Flat fee.....\$80.00
- (Pre-enter as many classes as you wish with same horse except for Liberty)
- Late entry fee per class.....\$30.00
There will be no flat fee available for post entries. Post entries and class changes will be accepted until 5 classes before the class entering the ring. There will be a \$30.00 fee for each additional class even for the horses pre-entered at the flat fee rate!
- Office fee per horse.....\$5.00
- Jump-off fee per horse (if you do not rent stalls).....\$10.00
- Stalls for entire weekend. Limit Two horse per stall.....\$35.00
(Horses stalled together MUST be compatible! NO exceptions!!)
- Shavings per bag.....\$7.50
(You may bring your own but stalls must be bedded with shavings)
- RV & Camper hookups per night.....\$25.00

**PLEASE READ ALL THE RULES AND REGULATIONS
THEY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!**

1. **CONDUCT:** Show management reserves the right to remove anyone from the show for inappropriate behavior without being liable for compensation. Part 8- Violations page 44 of the rule book.
2. Show Management and/or the Show Steward reserves the right to arbitrarily settle all matters, questions and differences incidental to this show and to cancel or combine classes as circumstances warrant, as long as said decision is in accordance with the by-laws and show rules of the ASPC/AMHR.
3. **ADDING CLASSES:** You may add a class up to 5 classes before the class you are adding. There will be a post entry fee of \$30.00 for each class and this **MUST** be done through the show office **ONLY!** Not at the gate.
4. Horses that are pre-entered at the flat fee rate cannot post enter any more classes without paying the post entry fee per each additional class.
5. **GATE RULES:** 2 minute gate call will be enforced, except for tack changes (must be given to gate person at least 2 classes prior to tack change). It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check in with the gate person and be on time for their class.
6. **DOGS:** All dogs brought on premises must be kept on a leash or contained at all times. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
7. There will be a 10% surcharge on all returned checks.
8. A copy, front & back of each horse's registration paper must accompany entries.

9. All horses must have a health certificate dated within 30 days prior to the show and a Negative Coggins dated within 12 months prior to the show
10. Shavings, RV & Camper Hookups to be paid in the Horse Show office or may be paid in advance with your entries.

Remember to fill out your judge evaluation form that will be included in your show packet!!

PLEASE NOTE ALL CHANGES

CLASS INFORMATION:

CROSS ENTERING: Country Pleasure Driving and Western Country Pleasure horses cannot enter any Pleasure driving classes.

Park Harness horses cannot enter any Country or Pleasure driving classes.

Modern Pleasure Shetlands MAY cross-enter into Modern Model, Youth, Showmanship, Group Classes, Liberty & Jumping.

YOUTH CLASSES: All youth MUST wear protective headgear (Certified ASTM/SEI) in Roadster and Under Saddle Classes. Headgear harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Walk-Trot: To be judged on the rail at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To halt and stand quietly. To be judged on the rider's ability to handle and aid the pony. Entry is made in the name of the rider. No stallions permitted. Not eligible for Leadline.

English Pleasure Under Saddle: Judged 60% on manners, quality, suitability to the rider and performance and 40% on conformation. Ponies are to enter to the right, shall be worked both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter and line up in the center of the ring. English saddle, equipment and dress are to be used in this class. Excessive speed and extreme action to be penalized. No stallions permitted.

Western Pleasure Under Saddle: Judged 60% on manners, quality, suitability to the rider and performance and 40% on conformation. Ponies are to enter to the right, shall be worked both ways of the ring at a walk, jog and lope and line up in the center of the ring. Only one hand may be used on the reins and hands must not be changed. Rider's hands must be clear of pony and saddle. Western saddle, equipment and dress are to be used in this class. Excessive speed and extreme action to be penalized. No stallions permitted.

Pee Wee Youth classes are for children 6 years & younger and may be accompanied by a spotter. This is a non-rated class.

ALL YOUTH AND AMATEURS must provide a copy of their current card to be eligible for points and Amateurs to show in the Amateur classes.

Precision Driving: The purpose of this competition is to test the skill of the driver and the obedience and handiness of the animal. Martingales and overchecks are prohibited for all vehicles. Sidechecks are optional. Failure to comply will incur elimination. Entries are required to drive over a course consisting of at least six to a maximum of eight obstacles. The track of the course will be irregular, necessitating changes of direction. To be judged 80% on the fault system and 20% on manners and performance.

Roadster In Hand: Exhibitor to wear stable colors – tailer, colors are optional. Pony must show in a Roadster performance class at the same show. Pony shall be shown with boots and roadster bridle. Overcheck is optional. Pony shall be led with a lead shank attached to a bit ring. Pony to be shown on the rail at a jog and at speed. To be judged 60% on conformation and 40% on way of going.

Please do not send copies of the coggins and health papers on your horses when you mail your entries. We will check your coggins and health papers when you pick up your packets at the show.
